3) FY2020 Amended UPWP

The BGMPO is required by federal regulations to prepare an annual work program, the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP), which details planning activities conducted with the use of federal transportation funds. The TAC approved the BGMPO 2020 UPWP at its January 15, 2019 meeting. Since that time, revisions were made to reflect the annual allocation in addition to a statewide allocation of available PL 2018 closeout funding. The FY 2020 allocation of Federal PL funds estimated at \$328,802 is received through a PL104 planning grant from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and \$20,000 in Section 5303 and \$120,000 in Section 5307 Transit Planning Funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). 4) **BGMPO Performance Targets**

INFORMATION: The MAP-21 final rule established the framework for States and MPOs to integrate performance measures and targets into their transportation planning processes. The MPO is required to set and show demonstrable progress towards meeting the performance targets and reflect those targets in their TIPs, MTPs and MPO Planning Agreements with transit agencies, NCDOT and other planning partners. MPO's can agree to adopt NCDOT's targets or commit to developing its own quantifiable performance measures.

RECOMMENDATION/ACTION: 1) Receive information and discuss; 2) Recommend TAC endorsement of NCDOT's performance targets supporting NCDOT's targets (for each of the five safety measures and pavement, bridge, and system performance) by resolutions.

5) Triangle Region Air Quality Conformity

NCDOT has released the revised FY 2020-2029 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The BGMPO is one of the MPOs in the Triangle Air Quality Region and must comply with federal air conformity

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requirements within its MTPs and MTIPs. The draft Triad Conformity Determination Report (CDR) will be available for public review and comment on August 21, 2019. The public review period for the BGMPO region will end on September 21, 2019. 6) BGMPO Title VI Plan Update

The BGMPO Title VI Plan was developed to guide the MPO in its administration and management of Title VI-related activities. The Limited English Proficiency (LEP) portion of the plan ensures that individuals with limited English proficiency have meaningful access to the transportation planning process. The Office of Civil Rights requested MPOs update Title VI Plans to be in compliance with current federal and state guidelines. The report is available on the BGMPO website at www.bgmpo.org.

7) SPOT 6.0 Update

The Strategic Prioritization Office of Transportation (SPOT) P6.0 Workgroup finalized the P6.0 Schedule that reflects an adjustment in the Future 2023-2032 STIP release and extended the P6.0 project submission deadline to Friday, May 1, 2020. The SPOT P6.0 project submission extension has resulted in the BGMPO revising its P6.0 schedule.
