<u>INFORMATION:</u> The Burlington – Graham MPO is permitted a maximum of seventeen (17) projects per transportation mode for SPOT evaluation and scoring by the July 31, 2020 deadline. The MPO P6.0 Draft Project List consists of 17 highway projects, 17 bicycle and pedestrian projects, 6 rail projects, 1 aviation project, and 1 transit project. The draft project list and map of highway and bicycle and pedestrian projects are included in the agenda packets. On May 19, 2020 the TAC approved releasing the MPO Draft P6.0 Project List for a 30-day public review and comment period. MPO staff recommends approval of the Draft P6.0 Project List for SPOT On!ine submission pending no public comments. The 2029 -2032 STIP development schedule is as follow:
