INFORMATION: The Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro MPO, Burlington-Graham MPO, Triangle Area RPO and NCDOT have worked collaboratively to develop transportation improvement strategies in an effort to improve NC 54 from I-85 in Graham to Old Fayetteville Road in Carrboro travel conditions. The study, conducted by VHB, included evaluating multimodal alternatives and addressing congestion, safety, and access management issues. The NC 54 Corridor Draft Plan will have a 30-day public comment period beginning October 15. The DCHC MPO will conduct a public meeting on November 14, 2018. A link to the Draft plan:

INFORMATION: The deadline for allocating local input points to SPOT 5.0 Division Needs projects is November 2, 2018 for non-hurricane impacted MPOs/RPOs. At the September 18, 2018 TCC meeting, staff presented recommendations for local input points for Division Needs projects. The TCC made the decision to delay allocating points until its October 16, 2018 meeting. The BGMPO Division Needs project list with SPOT scores is attached for TCC review and point assignment. NCDOT requires letters of local match

support for Division non-highway (bike/ped/rail/transit) projects that are programmed in the Draft 2020-2029 STIP.
